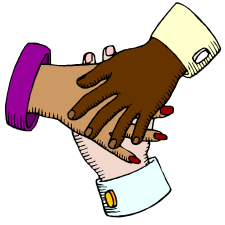
The groups have been extremely constructive and helpful in providing feedback to the practice about patient services, offering improvements and suggestions.

We are constantly looking at different ways to improve the

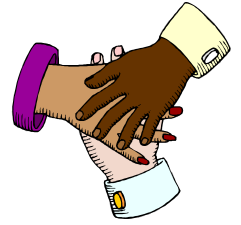


patient experience and this forum gives the group the opportunity to have their say and see their own ideas implemented in the practice.

You may wonder from time to time about the new names you hear mentioned when you're offered appointments with our GPs. We are an accredited GP Training Practice which means that we have qualified doctors completing their training at the surgery in specialising as a general practitioner .

Each registrar doctor is with us for a period of between 6-12 months.

These doctors are fully qualified meaning that the standard of care delivered by the registrars is no less than what you expect from our resident GPs.

We also have the additional F2s (Foundation doctors) who are gaining experience in the GP environment following the completion of their undergraduate medical training.
